The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$22,500 from the FY 2022 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for the following purposes:

**Victim Service Center of Central Florida. – \$5,000.** This contribution is in support of the Cheers to Change benefit event on April 1, 2022 at the Orlando Science Center to raise funding for continued prevention education in the community, and healing services for victims of violent crime, sexual assault, and other traumatic circumstances.

**Boy Scouts of America Central Florida Council - \$17,500.** This contribution will provide funding to support at-risk youth with guidance and role models through scouting. This program will enable youth to recognize and reach their full potential by making the right choices to accomplish their goals.

**ACTION REQUESTED: Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$22,500 from the FY 2022 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for an eligible contribution to Victim Service Center of Central Florida (\$5,000) and Boy Scouts of America Central Florida Council (\$17,500).**

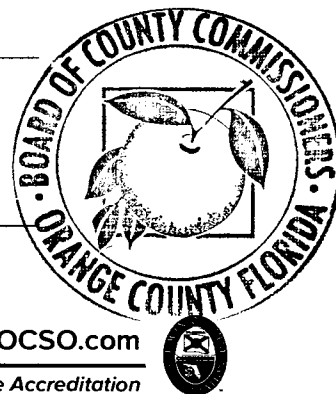
