#### **ACTION REQUESTED:**

Approval of Amendment No. 2, Contract Y20-144B, Liquid Polymer for South Water Reclamation Facility (SWRF), Polymer for Centrifuge Application, with Polydyne, Inc., in the amount of \$274,530, for a revised contract amount of \$783,725.

## PROCUREMENT:

This amendment adds funding due to an increase in processing of biosolids using the centrifuge application as the SWRF has completed the installation of a second centrifuge and 100% of the biosolids are being processed using the centrifuge application, causing a demand for more polymer.
