The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$17,000 from the FY 2020 Law Enforcement Trust Fund for the following purposes:

Contributions:

Boys & Girls Clubs of Central Florida - \$15,000. This organization provides a compelling alternative to youth crime, gang membership, drugs, and other negative influences that affect our youth today by reaching children at an early age and providing positive activities and encouragement.

Early Learning Coalition of Orange County - \$2,000. This organization provides information to parents for child care resources, as well as the School Readiness programs and the Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten programs that provide free access to education for all eligible four year-olds.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$17,000 from the FY 2020 Law Enforcement Trust Fund to provide eligible contributions to Boys & Girls Clubs of Central Florida (\$15,000) and Early Learning Coalition of Orange County (\$2,000).

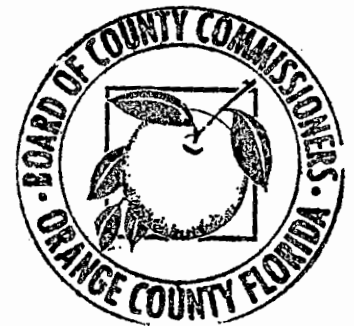

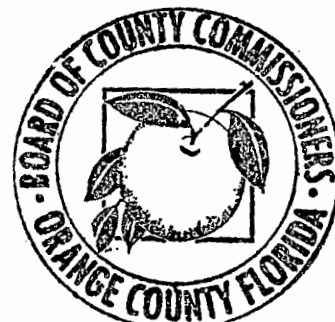
