ordinance: AN ORDINANCE RELATED TO RENT STABILIZATION IN ORANGE COUNTY; ENACTING A NEW ARTICLE XIII, DIVISION 2 OF THE ORANGE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES ("CODE"), SECTION 25-380 THROUGH SECTION 25-449; PROVIDING A SHORT TITLE AND LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS AND PURPOSE; LIMITING RENT INCREASES FOR CERTAIN RENTAL UNITS IN MULTIFAMILY STRUCTURES FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR; REQUIRING CERTAIN RESIDENTIAL LANDLORDS TO SUBMIT A RENTAL UNIT REGISTRATION STATEMENT; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION; CALLING FOR A REFERENDUM; PROVIDING BALLOT LANGUAGE; REQUIRING PUBLIC NOTICE OF SUCH REFERENDUM; PROVIDING THAT THE RENT STABILIZATION ORDINANCE WILL TAKE EFFECT ONLY UPON APPROVAL BY THE ELECTORATE; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF LAWS IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
