ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y17-168-TA, Web Based Driver Education, to the low responsive and responsible bidder, DST, Inc., in the estimated contract award amount of \$170,625 for a 3-year term. Further request authorization for the Procurement Division to renew the contracts for two additional 1-year terms.

PROCUREMENT:

This contract provides for annual driver education training to County employees annually.

FUNDING:

Funds are available in account number 5510 025 0328 3197.

APPROVALS:

The Risk Management and Business Development Divisions concur with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

Four bids were received in response to this Invitation for Bids and were evaluated for responsiveness, responsibility and price. Award is recommended to the low responsive and responsible bidder, DST, Inc.

The bid submitted by Interactive Education Concepts, Inc. was determined to be non-responsible as their references were unverifiable and the driver education software did not meet the minimum requirements.
