Environmental Protection Commission Recommendation for

Request for Waiver for Sand Lake 2019, LLC Dock

Construction Permit BD-21-01-009.

The applicant, Sand Lake 2019, LLC, is requesting a boat dock construction permit with approval of a waiver to Orange County Code (Code), Chapter 15, Article IX, Section 15-342(b) (terminal platform size). The project site is located at 6265 Sand Lake Vista Drive, Orlando, FL 32819. The Parcel ID number is 02-24-28-7851-07-000. The subject property is located adjacent to Big Sand Lake in District 1.

On January 15, 2021, the Environmental Protection Division (EPD) issued a Semi-Private Dock Construction Permit (BD-20-12-191) for an observation platform on the subject parcel to serve a multi-family development. The size of the permitted terminal platform for BD-20-12-191 was 980 square feet. The maximum allowable terminal platform size for this parcel is 1,000 square feet.

On January 19, 2021, EPD received a new Application to Construct a Dock in order to add a floating kayak launch and associated gangway to the already permitted dock. Included with the application was an Application for Waiver to Section 15-342(b) to authorize a larger-than-allowed terminal platform totaling 1,468 square feet in size.

Notification of the waiver request was sent to all shoreline property owners within a 300-foot radius of the property. No objections were received.

EPD staff evaluated the waiver request for compliance with the criteria for approval. The recommendation of the Environmental Protection Officer (EPO) is to approve the request for waiver to Code, Chapter 15, Article IX, Section 15-342(b) based on a finding that pursuant to Section 15-350(a)(2)(1), the applicant has demonstrated that negative effects to the environment due to shading impacts from the excess terminal platform size would be offset through a proposed mitigation payment of \$1,080 to the Conservation Trust Fund (CTF). Additionally, the applicant has demonstrated that there will be no adverse effects from the proposed waiver on abutting shoreline owners pursuant to Section 15-350(a)(2)(2), as no objections were received.

Based upon evidence and testimony presented at the March 31, 2021 Environmental Protection Commission (EPC) public hearing, the EPC unanimously voted to accept the findings and recommendation of the EPO, and made a recommendation to approve the request for waiver to Section 15-342(b) to increase the maximum terminal platform size from 1,000 square feet to 1,468 square feet with a payment of \$1,080 to the CTF within 60 days of the decision of the Board.








