Equipment:

Restroom/Shower Trailer – \$65,000. The purchase will provide a new four stall restroom/shower trailer to support the Critical Incident Management Team, Emergency Response Team, and other emergency units in order to accommodate long-term deployments where restroom and shower facilities are not readily available.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$65,000 from the FY 2022 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-Federal Forfeitures for an eligible expense for restroom/shower trailer.
