30	Public nuisance shall mean any place or premises that is alleged to have been used:					
32	(1) By a criminal street gang for the purpose of conducting a pattern of criminal street gang activity as defined by F.S. § 874.03;					
34	(2) On more than two (2) occasions within a six -month period, as the site of a violation of F.S. § 796.07, that pertains to					
36	prostitution;					

38	(3) On more than two (2) occasions within a six-month period, as the site of the unlawful sale, delivery, manufacture or cultivation of any controlled substance; or					
40	(4) On one (1) occasion as the site, of the unlawful possession of a controlled substance, where such possession					
42	constitutes a felony and that has been previously used on more than one (1) occasion as the site of the unlawful sale, delivery,					
44	manufacture or cultivation of any controlled substance; or					
46	(5) On more than two (2) occasions within a six-month period, as the site of a violation of F.S. § 812.019, relating to dealing in stolen property; or					
48	(6) On more than two (2) occasions within a six-month period, as the site of a violation of any combination of the following:
