The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$25,000 from the FY 2023 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for the following purposes:

Contributions:

Legal Aid Society – \$5,000. This contribution provides funding for a sponsorship for the 15th Annual Breakfast of Champions fundraising event on November 17, 2022 that raises funding to provide free, quality legal services to qualified, low-income residents in Orange County.

Victim Advocate Squad – \$20,000. A contribution for the Orange County Sheriff's Victim Advocate Squad to assist victims and survivors of crime with emergency needs for food, clothing, shelter, and other life necessities.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$25,000 from the FY 2023 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for eligible contributions to the Legal Aid Society (\$5,000) and Victim Advocate Squad (\$20,000).

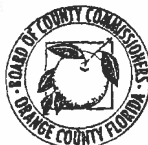
