SUBJ: Installation of "No Parking" signs on Hamlin Groves Trail

Citizens have expressed concern regarding insufficient sight distance on the west side of Hamlin Groves Trail.

The Traffic Engineering Division conducted a sight distant study and determined that at least 200 feet of clear sight distance is necessary from adjacent driveways. The Orange County Sheriff's Office also identified unsafe site conditions for drivers while exiting the businesses driveways. Based on Florida Design Manual criteria and the findings from the study, staff recommends restricting parking at the current parking bays on the west side of Hamlin Groves between Shoreside Way and New Independence Parkway at all times.

Staff recommends that the Board approve the "No Parking" signs installation on the west side of Hamlin Groves between Shoreside Way and New Independence Parkway.

Action Requested: Approval of "No Parking" signs installation on the west side of Hamlin Groves Trail between Shoreside Way and New Independence Parkway. District 1.


