Collegiate Pathways, Inc. Addendum to the FY 2022-23 Grant

Agreement

On January 10, 2023, the Board approved funding a grant agreement for the period of October 1, 2022, through September 30, 2023, with Collegiate Pathways, Inc. (Tech Sassy Girlz) to provide workforce development programs and recruitment across underrepresented demographics in our community.

The County desires to grant additional funding for the purchase of refurbished laptops and related equipment to support Tech Sassy Girlz' afterschool program for middle school girls and its fulltime summer workforce development for high school girls focused on software and web development.

The addendum to the agreement has been reviewed by the County Attorney's Office.

ADDENDUM TO FY 2023 GRANT AGREEMENT

THIS ADDENDUM, is made and entered into this <u>23</u> day of <u>May</u>, 2023, by and between ORANGE COUNTY, a charter county and political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as the "County," and COLLEGIATE PATHWAYS, INC., DBA TECH SASSY GIRLZ, hereinafter referred to as "TECH SASSY GIRLZ".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the County and TECH SASSY GIRLZ previously entered into that FY 2023 Grant Agreement on January 10, 2023 ("Agreement"), pursuant to which the County granted funds to support TECH SASSY GIRLZ' operations within the precollegiate STEM education industry; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to grant additional funding for the purchase of refurbished laptops and related equipment to support TECH SASSY GIRLZ' afterschool program for middle school girls and its fulltime summer workforce development for high school girls focused on software and web development; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to amend the Agreement to provide additional funding pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Agreement as amended herein.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

Section 1. Additional County Obligation. In addition to the County Contribution set forth in the Agreement, the County hereby grants to TECH SASSY GIRLZ Thirteen Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$13,000.00) ("Additional County Contribution") to be administered and disbursed by TECH SASSY GIRLZ solely for the purposes set forth in Exhibit "A". Any funds not spent or encumbered by September 30, 2023 for the designated purpose set forth in Exhibit "A" shall be returned to the County. The Additional County Contribution shall be made in one (1) installment following full execution of this Addendum within 30 days of County's receipt of an invoice. Any performance report required by the Agreement and due following the execution of this Addendum shall also address the services that were funded by the Additional County Contribution.

Section 2. Other Terms and Conditions. Any terms and conditions of the Agreement not expressly modified by this Addendum shall remain in full force and effect.

TECH SASSY GIRLZ

ACTIVITY FOR WHICH FUNDING IS REQUESTED

Funding in the additional amount of \$13,000 for FY23 will be used to support TECH SASSY GIRLZ' repurposing of laptops for teaching computer science, technology, engineering, software and web development. TECH SASSY GIRLZ' will uses these laptops for the next several years in their afterschool programs serving underserved students (i.e. Tech Sassy Girlz Code) and the full-time summer workforce development programs (including Pearls in Tech). Beyond planning, hosting, raising complementary funding, and executing an annual event for this scope of work, TECH SASSY GIRLZ commits to showing the County's STEM Careers promotional videos at least once during the event, as well as working with County staff, as needed, to collaborate on how County staff can support the event/program with mentors and volunteers. If appropriate and available, County staff should be prioritized in the itinerary to present the video and/or speak at the event. Marketing efforts for the event/programs should especially target middle and high school student participation from the following zip codes of Orange County, if a pre-collegiate program: 32808, 32805, 32839, 32811, 32818, 32810, 32801, 32822, and 32703.
