SUBJECT: Approval of Amendment No. 5, Contract Y19-186B, Removal and Processing Waste Tires, Lot B

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval of Amendment No. 5, Contract Y19-186B, Removal and Processing Waste Tires, Lot B, with Empire Tire of Edgewater, LLC, in the amount of \$166,500, for a revised contract amount of \$185,000.

PROCUREMENT:

This amendment increases the quantity of tire removal from 100 tons to 1,000 tons, which is necessary to maintain the removal of oversized waste tires and their processing.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 4410-038-1042-3197.

APPROVALS:

The Solid Waste Division concurs with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

Contract Y19-186B was awarded within Procurement's authority on May 9, 2019, in the total estimated contract amount of \$18,500 for a one-year term with further approval for the Procurement Division to renew the contract for four additional one-year terms.

The landfill has seen an increase in the quantity of oversized tires being delivered for disposal/recycling. This contract amendment will allow the Division to maintain compliance of the tire area and assure proper disposition of these tires.
