SUBJECT:

Approval of Contract Y20-1092, Prenatal Care Services

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval of Contract Y20-1092, Prenatal Care Services, with the Department of Health, Orange County, in the estimated contract amount of \$380,000 for a one-year term. Further request authorization for the Procurement Division to renew the contract for four additional one-year terms.

PURPOSE:

This contract provides comprehensive prenatal care by a licensed obstetrician to uninsured, underinsured, and medically indigent residents of Orange County.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 0001-060-2502-8610.

DISCUSSION:

In accordance with the Code of Ordinances, Part I, Chapter 17, Article III, Section 17-286 – Application and exclusions, agreements between the Board and other governmental entities are excluded from competitive procurement requirements.

The program will provide comprehensive prenatal care designed to identify members who are pregnant, encourage early and ongoing prenatal care, and increase member's access to perinatal information. Funding will support the provision of comprehensive prenatal care by a licensed obstetrician to uninsured, underinsured, and medically indigent residents of Orange County. The Florida Department of Health, Orange County will provide services by an obstetrics practice in the local medical community. Prenatal care is to be delivered in an obstetrics clinic where there is one patient record and will be provided by a licensed obstetrician, nurse practitioner, or nurse midwife.

Case management will also be provided to patients identified as high-risk pregnancies. This is determined by conducting a *Risk Appraisal for Pregnant Women and* this will be completed for all patients.

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Prenatal care services will include the following:

- 1. Initial exam
- 2. All prenatal visits performed at medically appropriate intervals up to the date of delivery
- 3. Routine prenatal laboratories during the prenatal period
- 4. Sonograms
- 5. Care for pregnancy related conditions, such as nausea, vomiting, cystitis, and vaginitis
- 6. Post-partum check-up

Price reasonableness has been established by comparison to the annual cost of services offered under the current contract, which remains unchanged.
