WHEREAS, on [insert date of meeting], the Board of County Commissioners approves revisions to the existing Traffic Calming Program to include additional traffic safety countermeasures applicable to various classifications of roadway in urban, commercial, and residential areas, along with updated funding participation requirements; and

WHEREAS, on April 5, 1994, the Board of County Commissioners approved the installation of speed humps under specific conditions on various roadways throughout Orange County; and

WHEREAS, the criteria originally adopted in 1994 now require updates to incorporate modern methodologies and technologies to reflect current transportation needs; and

WHEREAS, Orange County is committed to adopting state-of-the-art traffic calming guidelines, criteria, and design standards that support the County's Vision Zero and Complete Streets initiatives; and

WHEREAS, Orange County will develop a comprehensive traffic calming toolbox that includes a variety of roadway treatments based on traffic, speed, and volume thresholds, including, but not limited to, traffic circles, chicanes, speed tables, raised intersections, curb extensions, and bulb-outs; and

WHEREAS, Orange County will fully fund the Traffic Calming Program without requiring a financial match from residents, in order to expedite implementation and ensure equitable access to safety improvements throughout the County, and particularly in underserved communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ORANGE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS:

Section 1. Traffic Calming Program. Orange County approves the revisions to the current program. The implementation of such traffic calming measures has evolved and expanded from a neighborhood-wide to a county-wide approach to curb speeding and improve safety for all road users. These program revisions were derived from vigorous analysis and constitute industry best practices
