At the request of the McCraney Property Company, staff conducted a speed study on Oak Crossing Road. The complaint was originated due to street racing on Oak Crossing Road at night and on the weekends. The speed study showed very high speeds on the road especially on the weekend.

The McCraney Property Company is the only property owner that abuts and directly accesses Oak Crossing Road. Staff is proposing to install two speed tables on the street due to the high volume of truck traffic. The McCraney Property Company has agreed to fund the project 50% with the County and funds will be submitted prior to construction.

Action Requested: Approval to construct speed tables on Oak Crossing Road.



On behalf of Bent Oak Phase 2 Industrial, LLC, this letter confirms authorization for the installation of two speed tables (per the attached specifications provided by Orange County; exact installation locations to be determined) on Oak Crossing Road between Taft Vineland Road and Boice Pond Road.

As you are aware, and based on the speed study that you conducted between 12/12/17 and 12/17/17, it is clear that Oak Crossing Road is experiencing excessive speeds as a result of active vehicle racing that takes place on a daily basis. The racing has led to property damage, trespassing, loitering, littering and potentially dangerous interactions with those committing these acts. The existing racing element is disrupting business and tenant safety and we are confident that the speed tables will eliminate the ability to race along this road.
