ACTION REQUESTED:

Selection of one firm and one ranked alternate to provide Consulting Services for Sustainability Initiatives, Request for Proposals Y19-170-KB, from the following firms listed alphabetically:

FCM Engineering
Le-Huu Partners
TLC Engineering Solutions, Inc.

Request authorization for the Procurement Division to negotiate and execute a 3-year contract within a total budget amount of \$591,000. Further request authorization for the Procurement Division to renew the contract for two additional 1-year terms.
