FIRST AMENDMENT AND RENEWAL OF THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN

THE SCHOOL BOARD OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA AND ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT AND RENEWAL (this "First Amendment") is made effective as of the date last executed below (the "Effective Date") and entered into by and between ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA, a charter county and political subdivision of the State of Florida ("COUNTY") and THE SCHOOL BOARD OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA, a public corporate organized and existing under the constitution and laws of the State of Florida ("SBOC").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, COUNTY and SBOC entered into that certain Interlocal Agreement approved by the Orange County Board of County Commissioners on July 7, 2020 (the "Interlocal Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Agreement Initial Term expires on June 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY and SBOC both desire to renew the Interlocal Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY desires and SBOC agrees to amend Section 6. Insurance, of the Interlocal Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY and SBOC hereby confirm and ratify, except as modified below, all of the terms, conditions and covenants of the Interlocal Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, COUNTY and SBOC agree as follows:

- 1. The recitals set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated into this First Amendment by this reference.
- 2. COUNTY and SBOC hereby agree to exercise the first of the Renewal Terms provided for in Section 2.B. of the Interlocal Agreement. The first Renewal Term shall be for a term of one (1) year commencing on July 1, 2023 and terminating on June 30, 2024. Pursuant to Section 2.B.i. of the Interlocal Agreement, the COUNTY's Manager of the Real Estate Management Division, or designee, has authority to execute this First Renewal on behalf of the COUNTY.

3. Paragraph 6. Insurance, of the Interlocal Agreement is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Section 6. Insurance. Without waiving its right to sovereign immunity as provided in Section 768.28, Florida Statutes, SBOC acknowledges to be self-insured for General Liability and Automobile Liability with coverage limits of as set forth in Section 768.28, Florida Statutes.

The SBOC agrees to maintain commercial insurance or to be self-insured for Workers' Compensation & Employers' Liability in accordance with Florida Statute 440.

Upon request the SBOC shall provide an affidavit or Certificate of Insurance evidencing self-insurance or commercial insurance up to sovereign immunity limits, which the COUNTY agrees to find acceptable for the coverage mentioned above.

The COUNTY's failure to request proof of insurance or to identify any deficiency in coverage or compliance with the foregoing requirements shall not relieve the SBOC of its liability and obligations under this agreement.

All other terms and conditions of the above reference Interlocal Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
