May 2019 Neighborhood Pride Capital Improvement Grants

The Neighborhood Services Division administers the Neighborhood Pride Grant Program that provides funds for citizen organizations to enhance the quality of their neighborhoods. The Neighborhood Pride Grants are available countywide in amounts ranging between \$1,500 to \$10,000. Neighborhood Pride Grant applications are accepted year-round and are reviewed monthly by the Neighborhood Grants Advisory Board (NGAB). Neighborhood Pride Capital Improvement Grant provides funding to neighborhood organizations, homeowner associations, and non-profit organizations for physical and aesthetic improvements to their community.

The NGAB is recommending approval of May 2019 Capital Improvement Grants to Summerport Property Owners Association (\$10,000) and Winter Hill Homeowners Association (\$8,325) (see Attachment A). The grant requests are displayed in greater detail in Attachments B and C. The grant requests were reviewed by staff and presented to the NGAB for recommendation. The applications were reviewed based on project feasibility, organizational readiness, and benefit to the community. In addition, the applications were reviewed against the County's permitting requirements to ensure that the project would comply with appropriate County codes.

Finally, the organizations are required to sign a letter of agreement recognizing their responsibilities throughout the grant process, document the appropriate match, and demonstrate an ability to maintain the project.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval of Neighborhood Grants Advisory Board's recommendations of Neighborhood Pride Capital Improvement Grants to Summerport Property Owners Association (\$10,000) and Winter Hill Homeowners Association (\$8,325). Districts 1 and 6

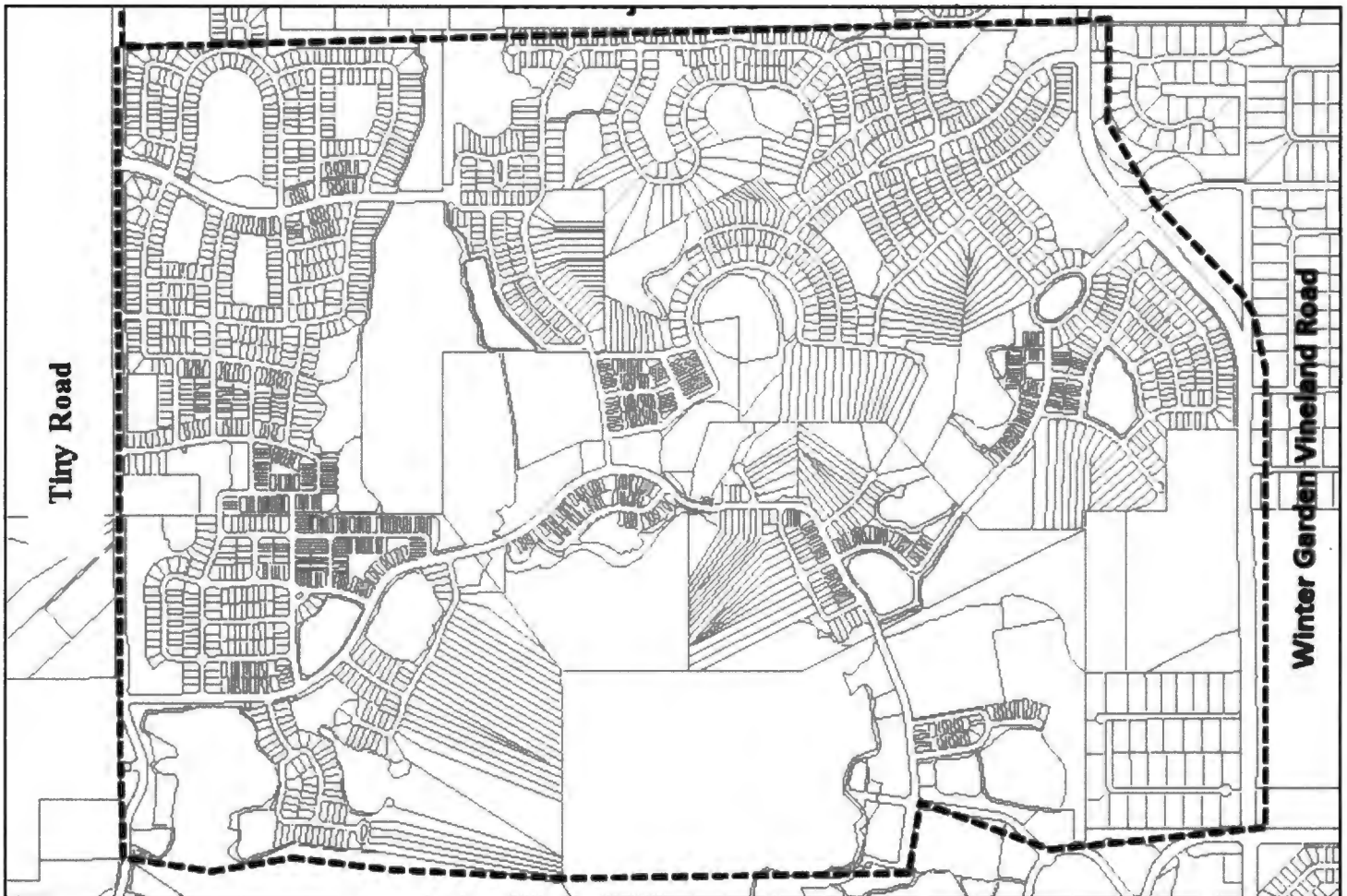
