To consider amending Chapter 17, Article III of the Orange County Code related to the following:

- Current language in the ordinance inhibits the use of certain Construction Management at Risk (CMAR) and Design-Build solicitations.
- Desire is to have flexibility in contracting in order to complete public construction projects in the most cost effective and efficient manner.



Overview of Proposed Changes

■ The definition of Good Faith Effort and the language regarding submission of subcontracts will both be updated to allow submission of certain documents at a different point in the process for Design Build and CMAR projects than is required for other types of solicitations.



■ Approval of an Ordinance Pertaining to Procurement in Orange County, Florida; Revising Chapter 17, Article III, Division 4 ("Minority/Women Business Enterprise"), Section 17-319 ("Definitions") and Section 17-321 ("Contract and Subcontract Goals") of the Orange County Code; And Providing an Effective Date.
