Project Administration Subrecipient Agreements

On August 9, 2022, the Board approved the 2022-2023 Annual Action Plan for housing and community development activities under federal Community Development Block Grant and Emergency Solutions Grant funded by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The One-Year Action Plan utilizes some of the funding to support the delivery of social services and homeless activities. These activities are targeted to low-income persons and include, but are not limited to, home delivered meals for the elderly, subsidized childcare, job training and placement for disabled individuals, and emergency shelter for the homeless.

To implement the projects in the HUD approved 2022-2023 Annual Action Plan, Project Administration Agreements must be executed with the public service agencies.
