Equipment

**ACTION REQUESTED:**

Ratification of Purchase Order M101408, Stryker Transport Unit Equipment, with Stryker Medical, in the amount of \$330,310.35.

**PROCUREMENT:**

This purchase order provides equipment to prepare three transport units to assist with preparedness for potential increase call loads related to COVID-19 response.

**FUNDING:**

Funding is available in account numbers 5895-019-8019-6410, 5895-019-8019-4123, 5895-019-8019-4115 and 5895-019-8019-3820.

**APPROVALS:**

The Fire Rescue Department concurs with this recommendation.

**REMARKS:**

In August 2014, the Board approved Stryker Power Pro XT Stretcher as the standardized transport platform provider for current and future purchases.

In response to COVID-19 and to meet the demands of diagnostics for this acute response, the Fire Rescue Department purchased three LIFEPAK 15 Monitor/Defibrillator devices, Lucas compression devices, and stretcher cots with power load system to prepare three new rescue units to respond to a potential increase call load. Pricing is consistent with current Stryker industry pricing and with recent purchases made by the County, therefore is considered fair and reasonable.
