SUBJ:Decrease of speed limit on Chickasaw Trail starting 230 feet north of<br/>American Rose Parkway to El Prado Avenue from 45 mph to 35 mph

Recently a concerned citizen requested Orange County review the posted 45 mph speed limit on Chickasaw Trail from north of American Rose Parkway to El Prado Avenue. The citizen believes the current posted speed limit is too high for the conditions on this section of the road which creates a safety concern.

Traffic Engineering Division conducted a speed study which resulted in an 85<sup>th</sup> percentile speed of 40 mph, with the highest percentage of vehicles traveling between 30 to 40 mph. Also noted is a history of severe crashes on a curve just south of this section of Chickasaw Trail at El Prado Avenue, and due to the existing field conditions staff is in support of an overall safety improvement project.

Based on the results of the speed study, staff recommends that the Board approve a decrease in the posted speed limit of 45 mph to 35 mph on Chickasaw Trail starting 230 feet north of American Rose Parkway to El Prado Avenue.

Action Requested: Approval to decrease the speed limit on Chickasaw Trail starting 230 feet north of American Rose Parkway to El Prado Avenue from 45 mph to 35 mph. District 3.
