Approval to Decrease the Speed Limit in Mount Plymouth Lakes

Subdivision

A concerned citizen has requested Orange County to review the posted speed limits within the Mount Plymouth Lakes Subdivision. The posted speed limit within Mount Plymouth Lakes Subdivision is 30 mph. The citizen believes the current posted 30 mph speed limit is too high and creates a safety concern.

Based on the Florida Statute 316.189 and a field review of traffic conditions, staff recommends the Board approve a decrease in the posted speed limit from 30 mph to 25 mph on the following streets: Lake Lerla Drive; Dunlap Drive; Fortune Lane; Sanson Drive; Slote Drive; Oren Court; Disney Drive; Prevo Drive, and Stanwin Drive.

Action Requested: Approval to decrease the speed limit in Mount Plymouth Lakes Subdivision from 30 mph to 25 mph. District 2.



Mount Plymouth Lakes Subdivision Consent Agenda District Map






District 2: Commissioner Christine Moore
