Modification of the Orange County Community Redevelopment

Plan.

On April 9, 1990, the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") established the Community Redevelopment Agency of Orange County, Florida (commonly known as the "OBT CRA") pursuant to Chapter 163, Florida Statutes (the "Community Redevelopment Act") and Resolution No. 90-M-23, finding the existence of one or more slum or blighted areas in the City of Orlando and the County in an area of the County known as South Orange Blossom Trail. On June 11, 1990, the Board adopted a Redevelopment Plan (the "Plan") with an initial term of 30 years. This OBT CRA will therefore sunset on December 31, 2020 unless extended.

The Board, sitting as the OBT CRA has contracted with the Orange Blossom Development Board, Inc., (the "Development Board") to administer redevelopment programs in the community redevelopment area since 1991. In 2017, the Development Board commissioned a study of the existing conditions within the Community Redevelopment Area (the "Area"). The report indicated that little redevelopment or investment in the Area had occurred since the Plan was adopted and proposed to update the Plan in various ways including an extension of the Plan for a period of thirty (30) years beyond the expiration of its initial term. County staff reviewed the report and concurs with the conclusion that continued redevelopment in the Area is necessary and recommends an extension of the Plan for a period of thirty (30) years. However, further analysis of the best methods for implementation of the Plan may be necessary and staff does not recommend adoption of the report itself or an expansion of the boundaries of the Area.

Prior to the public hearing on the attached Resolution, the Board will convene as the Orange County Community Redevelopment Agency ("Agency") to consider the recommendation to extend the sunset date. After voting on the recommendation, the Board will adjourn as the Agency and re-convene as the Board to hold a public hearing on the attached Resolution.

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WHEREAS, on April 9, 1990, the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County, Florida (the "Board") established the Community Redevelopment Agency of Orange County, Florida (the "Agency") pursuant to the provisions of Part III, Chapter 163, Florida Statutes (the "Community Redevelopment Act") and Resolution No. 90-M-23, finding the existence of one or more slum or blighted areas in the City of Orlando and the County in an area of the County known as South Orange Blossom Trail (the "Community Redevelopment Area"); and

WHEREAS, on June 11, 1990, the Board adopted a Redevelopment Plan pursuant to the Community Redevelopment Act and Resolution No. 90-M-33 (the "Plan") with an initial term of thirty (30) years; and

WHEREAS, on June 11, 1990 the Board also enacted Ordinance No. 90-13 establishing a Community Redevelopment Trust Fund in order to implement community redevelopment in the Community Redevelopment Area; and

WHEREAS, on March 26, 1991, the Agency entered into an agreement with the Orange Blossom Trail Development Board, Inc., a Florida non-profit corporation (the "Development Board") on March 26, 1991 pursuant to which the Agency contracted with the Development Board to implement redevelopment programs in the Community Redevelopment Area; and

WHEREAS, on May 8, 2007, the Agency entered into a new agreement with the Development Board relating to redevelopment activities in the Community Redevelopment Area (the "Agreement") which Agreement, as amended, shall expire on January 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, in 2017, the Development Board commissioned a study by GAI Consultants, Inc. entitled "OBT Next" to evaluate the existing conditions within the Community Development Area (the "Area"); and

WHEREAS, the OBT Next report indicated that little redevelopment or investment in the Area had occurred since the Plan was adopted and proposed to (i) update the Plan, (ii) extend the Plan for a period of thirty (30) years beyond the expiration of its initial term, and (iii) expand redevelopment beyond the existing boundaries of the Area; and

the Board's findings in Resolution No. 90-M-23 and Resolution No. 90-M-33; and 50 WHEREAS, the Board also finds that the continued existence of the Agency and 52 rehabilitation or redevelopment of the Area is necessary in the best interests of the public health, safety and welfare and that such interests will best be served by an extension of its existence and 54 the Plan for a period of approximately twenty nine (29) years; that further study and analysis of the best methods for implementation of the Plan is necessary; and that its decision to extend the 56 Plan shall not be construed as an adoption of the entire OBT Next report itself or an expansion of the boundaries of the Area. 58 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY 60 COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA: 62 Section 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and adopted as a part of this Resolution. 64 The Board hereby adopts and approves the continued existence of the 66 Section 2. Agency and modification of the Plan to extend the duration of the Plan until September 30, 2049 at which time the Agency and the Plan shall terminate and cease to exist. 68 Section 3.
