On **April 5, 2022**, the Board of County Commissioners adopted the 2021-2 Out of Cycle Regular Cycle State-Expedited Review Amendment to the Orange County Comprehensive Plan.

The Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) has notified the Planning Division that they reviewed the amendment in accordance with the State-Expedited Review process and did not identify any provision that necessitated a challenge to the Ordinance adopting the amendment.

Therefore, in accordance with the 31-day appeal period, the effective date for the 2021-2 Out of Cycle Regular Cycle State-Expedited Review Amendment adopted by **Ordinance 2022-11** is **August 27, 2022**.

Dear Mayor Demings:

The Department of Economic Opportunity ("Department") has completed its review of the comprehensive plan amendment adopted by Orange County (Amendment No. 22-02ESR/County file 2021-2-C-FLUE-2) by Ordinance No. 2022-11 on April 5, 2022. We have reviewed the amendment in accordance with the expedited state review process set forth in Section 163.3184(2) and (3), Florida Statutes, and identified no provision that necessitates a challenge of the Ordinance adopting the amendment.

If the plan amendment is not challenged by an affected person, the amendment will become effective 31 days after the Department notified the local government that the plan amendment package was complete. If the plan amendment is challenged by an affected person, the amendment will not become effective until the Department or the Administration Commission enters a final order determining the amendment to be "In Compliance."
