Subject: Approval of Amendment No. 1, Contract Y18-806, International Drive
Transit Feasibility and Alternative Technology Assessment

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval of Amendment No. 1, Contract Y18-806, International Drive Transit Feasibility and Alternative Technology Assessment, with HDR Engineering, Inc. in the total amount of \$481,353.04, for a revised contract amount of \$1,431,607.12.

PROCUREMENT:

This amendment will analyze the potential of implementing a modern streetcar service or other premium transit alternatives as an urban circulator operating within the International Drive District. It will additionally expand the area of the original project footprint to include Destination Parkway from International Drive to Tradeshow Boulevard, Tradeshow Boulevard from Destination Parkway to Universal Boulevard, including Roadway Conceptual Analysis and incorporation of the results of the Kirkman Road Extension project (Universal Boulevard to Carrier Drive) into this study. The original study entailed a 2.8 mile study. This amendment will expand the study to cover a total of approximately 4.3 miles. To complete the work associated with this amendment, the contract time will be increased by an additional 90 calendar days from the Notice to Proceed.

FUNDING:

Partial funding in the amount of \$96,254.92 is available in account number 1246-072-3074-3110. The remaining \$385,098.12 will be encumbered in FY20.

APPROVALS:

The Transportation Planning Division concurs with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

On October 2, 2018, the Board approved award of contract Y18-806 to HDR Engineering, Inc. in the amount of \$950,254.08.
