01D05820-2, Modification Number 2

The Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has received Modification Number 2 to Grant No. PM-01D05820-2 from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to support the ongoing collection of data on the ambient air concentrations of fine particulate matter and to support the County's efforts with staying in compliance with National Ambient Air Quality Standards. The original grant was approved by the Board via consent agenda on May 5, 2020. Modification Number 1 provided the payment for the second fiscal year authorized by the original grant agreement. Modification Number 2 extends the project period and provides additional funding. For several years, EPD has received similar grants from EPA to perform these duties.

The size of particles in ambient air is directly linked to their potential for causing health problems. Small particles less than 2.5 microns in size pose the greatest risk because they can penetrate deeply into the lungs and cause a variety of health problems affecting the lungs and heart. This new grant agreement provides funding to support EPD's continued monitoring of concentrations of fine particulate matter for comparison to health-based standards established by EPA. This grant will coincide with the Specific Operating Agreement (SOA) between the Florida Department of Environmental Protection and the Board, which was approved by the Board on February 23, 2021. The SOA defines the scope of services that EPD will provide as a designated local air program.

The initial award amount authorized for this grant was \$70,554 with a project period from April 1, 2020 through March 31, 2022. Modification Number 2 extends the project period end date through March 31, 2024. The additional grant funding anticipated from EPA during the portion of the project period that extends from April 1, 2022 through

March 31, 2024 is \$70,440, which would increase the total budget period cost to \$140,994. The modification approves an initial increase in funding in the amount of \$26,250 and the remainder of the funding is anticipated to follow next fiscal year. Future awards are subject to the availability of federal funding. In accordance with the terms of the agreement, EPA agrees to a cost share of 100% of all approved budget period costs incurred up to and not exceeding \$26,250 (i.e., no match is required). EPD is not requesting additional funding or additional staff as part of this grant.

It is also requested that the EPD Manager be granted authorization to make nonsubstantial amendments to the agreement, including additional service periods, subject to availability of funds from the EPA.

As indicated in the Notice of Award, a representative from Orange County is not required to sign the agreement. The County's commitment to carry out this award is demonstrated by either drawing down the funds or not filing a notice of disagreement with the award terms and conditions within stipulated timeframes.

Cooperative Agreement, Grant No. PM-01D05820-2, Modification Number 2 was reviewed and approved as to form by the County Attorney's Office and the County Grants Oversight Committee.
