February 2022 Non-Profit Safety Grant

The Neighborhood Services Division administers the Non-Profit Safety Grant which provides funds up to \$10,000 to non-profit organizations to implement crime prevention and public safety related projects and initiatives in Orange County. This grant is supported by the local Crime Prevention Fund which also funds the Safe Neighborhoods Program, the Pine Hills Neighborhood Improvement District, and Orange Blossom Trail Safe Neighborhood.

After a detailed review of each grant application, the Neighborhood Services Division forwarded applications to the Neighborhood Grants Advisory Board (NGAB) for review on December 14, 2021. Upon approval, the non-profit organization must implement the project/initiative and will then be reimbursed by the County. There is no match required for this grant.

The NGAB is recommending approval of the Non-Profit Safety Grant to Aspire Health Partners, Inc. (\$10,000) The Non-Profit Safety Grant for February 2022 total \$10,000 (see attachment A). The grant request is displayed in greater detail in attachment B.
