
Copy of the Save Orange County petition:

Dear Mayor and County Commissioners,

You will hear two Public Hearings during Tuesday's June 2nd Board of County Commissioners Meeting: the Chuluota Road/419 PD&E, and the McCulloch Road PD&E Study.

After reviewing the Chuluota Road/419 widening plan, it is not acceptable. The size, scale, and cost of over \$70 million do not reflect the Rural Boundary, rural service area, or the rural settlements this roadway serves.

The design presented to you is the same design that the community rejected a year ago. None of the community's requested changes were incorporated. During the Chuluota Road/419 community meeting, residents supported reasonable safety enhancements, but were clear that those enhancements should reflect the character and needs of the community. First, we got the Grow that no one wanted. Now, the impact fees are being used to fund a roadway design that the community does not want. Throughout this process, residents have shown up, participated, and provided feedback, yet that feedback has been ignored.

Vote NO on the Chuluota Road/419 design as presented. We hope Orange County staff will return with a plan that incorporates the community-requested enhancements and better reflects the needs of this community.

Vote NO on the McCulloch Road design. Residents at the Community Meeting, both Orange and Seminole County, as well as Seminole County leaders, were overwhelmingly opposed to the widening of McCulloch Road and any potential that it would be connected to Chuluota Road/419. It's a C road, working as intended. There are many other roads that could use Orange County attention and resources.
