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Subject: Ratification of Purchase Order M108962, Emergency John Young Parkway  
Slope Restoration and Erosion Control

ACTION REQUESTED:

Ratification of Purchase Order M108962, Emergency John Young Parkway Slope Restoration and Erosion Control, with Brownies Septic & Plumbing, LLC in the amount of \$1,090,437.

PROCUREMENT:

The project provides for the emergency repairs to multiple slope failures of the John Young embankments approaching the bridge over the Florida turnpike.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 1002-072-4906-3816.

APPROVALS:

The Roads and Drainage Division concurs with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

As a result of Hurricane Ian, the Public Works Department identified multiple slope failures along approximately 3,440 feet of the John Young Parkway embankments approaching the bridge over the Florida turnpike. Some segments of the chain-link fence adjacent to the sidewalk at the top of the embankment also collapsed. Due to the emergency need of these repairs and for the safety of the road and pedestrians, this project was procured via emergency procedures. A purchase order was issued to Brownies Septic & Plumbing, LLC, a full-service contractor that has successfully performed similar projects with Public Works. They have experience working with these conditions and performing the necessary work in a timely manner to prevent similar problems that could endanger the main roadway. Pricing for these services is based off the County's current contract with Brownies Septic & Plumbing, LLC, which does not have the sufficient funds to cover the emergency repairs.
