Fleck in the regulated private business or municipality representative category with terms expiring December 31, 2025; the appointment of Dawson L. Amico to succeed Billy Butterfield in the agricultural interests representative category with a term expiring December 31, 2025; and the appointment of J. Gordon Spears to succeed Jared A. Gasper in the at large representative category with a term expiring December 31, 2026.
