Notice is hereby given to all owners of lands located within the boundaries of Orange County Florida that the Orange County Board of County Commissioners intends to use the uniform method for collection of non-ad valorem assessments levied by the Orange County Board of County Commissioners as set forth in Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes.

Take notice that pursuant to the provisions of Section 125.01 (1) (q), Florida Statutes, the Orange County Board of County Commissioners of Orange County, Florida, has received requests for the establishment and / or amendments of Municipal Service Benefit Unit's (MSBU's) for all the listed properties encompassing the boundaries as set forth in the detailed attachment. The Orange County Board of County Commissioners will hold public hearings to consider resolutions at a future date and which may adopt the MSBU's in accordance with Section 197.3632, and Section 125.01 (1) (q), Florida Statutes.

The purpose of this public hearing is not to impose a rate or levy an assessment, but rather to consider the adoption of a Resolution authorizing the Board to use the uniform method of collecting non-ad valorem assessments. Interested parties may appear at the Public Hearing to be heard regarding the use of the uniform method of collecting such non-ad valorem assessments.
