Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y22-748-FH, Fire Station Number 80 Replacement, to the low responsive and responsible bidder, Mulligan Constructors, Inc. in the total contract award amount of \$5,668,750.

PROCUREMENT:

Work under this contract consists of assessment and construction of a three-bay fire station to replace the existing station. The project is located in District 5.
