SUBJECT: Award of Invitation for Bids Y22-102-MV. Median Tree Program

### ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y22-102-MV, Median Tree Program, to the sole responsive and responsible bidder, James F. McCann, Inc., in the estimated contract award amount of \$2,988,620 for a three-year term.

### PROCUREMENT:

The median tree program provides all manpower, equipment, and materials for the removal of existing sod, trees, and shrubs on roadway medians as designed by the County. This includes maintenance of newly installed landscape for a period of two years.

#### FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 1002-072-5143-3816.

### APPROVALS:

The Traffic Engineering Division and the Business Development Division concur with this recommendation.

#### REMARKS:

One bid was received in response to this Invitation for Bids and was evaluated for responsiveness, responsibility, and price reasonableness. The bid submitted by James F. McCann, Inc. was determined to be fair and reasonable by staff when compared to past contracts for like services.

To ensure an open and competitive bid process, the Invitation for Bids was posted on the Orange County website and e-procurement portal. A query from staff to potential sources that declined to compete on this project resulted in the following findings:

- Aero GroundTek, LLC.: Declined to bid due to the lack of a guaranteed amount of contract value or specified work load requested. Additionally, there was no concise amount for a specific work area meaning mobilizing for a minimal quantity on a set cost per tree. This makes it difficult to price as quantity affects costs.
- Drummond's Tree Service: Did not provide a response to the inquiry.
- La Fleur Nurseries and Garden Center, LLC.: Did not provide a response to the inquiry.
- Greenleaf Landscape and Maintenance, Inc.: Did not provide a response to the inquiry.
- James Burger: Advised they missed deadline to submit a bid.
