SUBJ: **Installation of "No Parking" Signs on Oglesby Avenue**

A concerned citizen has requested that "No Parking" signs be established on both sides of Oglesby Avenue from Formosa Avenue to Clay Street. The no parking zone length is 1,295 feet.

The request for parking restrictions is to address pedestrian safety incidences and hazardous driving conditions caused by vehicles parking on the road creating blind spots at driveways and street corners. Ballots were mailed to the property owners impacted. Upon receipt of the ballots confirming that two-thirds of residents are in favor of the "No Parking" signs, the County will proceed with the installation request. The result of the survey indicated that 100% of the property owners approve the "No Parking" signs.

Staff recommends that the Board approve the installation of "No Parking" signs on both sides of Oglesby Avenue from Formosa Avenue to Clay Street.
