DONATION AGREEMENT

COUNTY OF ORANGE STATE OF FLORIDA

THIS DONATION AGREEMENT ("Agreement") made between **The School Board of Orange County, Florida**, a public corporate body organized and existing under the constitution and laws of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "School Board", and **Orange County**, a charter county and political subdivision of the state of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "County", (School Board and County shall be collectively identified as the "Parties").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, School Board is the owner of land described as a portion of Parcel Identification Numbers 16-22-31-0000-00-091 and 16-22-31-0000-00-152 on **Exhibit "A"** attached hereto ("Donation Property"), which abuts the south side of the University High School (HS) and the Orange Technical College (OTC) – East Campus ("School Board Property"); and

WHEREAS, County seeks to acquire the Donation Property for Right-of-Way (ROW) improvements of Eastwood Drive, as shown in **Exhibit "B"** to cure the roadway from being a substandard ROW; and

WHEREAS, School Board agrees to furnish said land for such purpose; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), each to the other paid, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. School Board agrees to convey the Donation Property to the County by Special Warranty Deed, free of all liens and encumbrances, except those acceptable to County, if any, in substantially the same form as attached in Exhibit C, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. County, may, at its sole cost and expense, elect to obtain a title commitment insuring title to Donation Property. Notwithstanding the foregoing, School Board has no obligation to cure any existing liens or encumbrances of record affecting title to Donation Property.
- 2. As-Is Disclaimer. COUNTY ACKNOWLEDGES, UNDERSTANDS AND AGREES THAT, EXCEPT AS SPECIFICALLY SET FORTH IN THIS AGREEMENT TO THE CONTRARY, THE PROPERTY DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" IS BEING DONATED BY SCHOOL BOARD IN ITS PRESENT PHYSICAL CONDITION, "AS-IS", AND THAT, SCHOOL BOARD MAKES ABSOLUTELY NO REPRESENTATIONS OR WARRANTIES WHATSOEVER WITH RESPECT TO THE PHYSICAL CONDITION OF THE PROPERTY. COUNTY AGREES THAT UPON THE CLOSING, COUNTY SHALL BE DEEMED TO HAVE ACCEPTED THE DONATION PROPERTY DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A", INCLUDING ANY FAULTS AND/OR PROBLEMS THAT WERE, OR COULD HAVE BEEN, DISCOVERABLE BY COUNTY PRIOR TO ENTERING INTO

THIS AGREEMENT. THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION 3 SHALL SURVIVE THE CLOSING.

- 3. This transaction constitutes a conveyance from a state agency or instrumentality to an agency of the state and is not subject to documentary stamp tax.
- 4. The Donation Property is exempt from ad valorem property taxes.
- 5. This transaction shall be closed and the Special Warranty Deed and other closing papers delivered on or before sixty (60) days from the Effective Date (hereinafter defined) of this Agreement. Closing shall take place at the office of the Orange County Real Estate Management Division, 400 E. South Street, Fifth Floor, Orlando, Florida 32801, or at such place as shall be mutually agreed upon by COUNTY
- 6. The County shall be responsible for payment of any and all real property transfer and transaction taxes and levies relating to the Donation Parcels as well as any title insurance premiums, otherwise, each party shall pay its own costs associated with the closing of the transaction contemplated here.
- 7. County shall, at its sole cost and expense, obtain and deliver to School Board a sketch of description of the Donation Property. The sketch of description will be prepared in accordance with Standards of Practice under Chapter 5J-17, of the Florida Administrative Code, Section 472.027, Florida Statutes.
- 8. County shall, at its sole cost and expense, obtain and deliver to School Board a boundary survey of the School Board Property remaining after the Donation Property is removed. The survey shall be certified to School Board and County and prepared in accordance with the minimum technical requirements and standards promulgated by the Florida Board of Professional Surveyor and Mappers, Chapter 5J-17, of the Florida Administrative Code, Section 472.027, Florida Statutes, and ALTA/NSPS Land Title Survey Standards.
- 9. This Agreement may be executed in up to two counterparts, each of which shall constitute an original, but both of which together shall constitute one and the same agreement, and this agreement shall be binding upon all parties so long as each signs one or more counterparts.
- 10. Effective Date: This agreement shall become effective on the date upon which it has been fully executed by the Parties.

THIS AGREEMENT supersedes all previous agreements or representations, either verbal or written, heretofore in effect between School Board and County made with respect to the matters herein contained, and when duly executed constitutes the AGREEMENT between School Board and County. No additions, alterations, or variations to the terms of this AGREEMENT shall be valid, nor can the provisions of this AGREEMENT be waived by either party unless expressly set forth in writing and duly signed.


