Establishment of a Multi-Way Stop Condition at the Intersection of

Dobbin Drive and Winder Trail

The Arbor Ridge K-8 neighborhood school, located at 2900 Logandale Drive, Orlando, FL 32817 has 754 students enrolled in the program, of which 328 students are walkers. Based on the high number of pedestrians crossing at the Dobbin Drive and Winder Trail intersection, the community requested consideration for a multi-way stop control.

The results of the safety and operational analysis indicate that the multi-way stop control is warranted. The installation of stop signs at each leg of the intersection will address current vehicle-pedestrian conflict issues, while enhancing the safety for pedestrians using designated crosswalks.

Staff recommends that the Board approve the establishment of a multi-way stop condition at Dobbin Drive and Winder Trail intersection.

Dobbin Drive and Winder Trail. District 5.


