Orange County Sheriff's Office Request

The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$28,000 from the FY 2022 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for the following purposes:

National Alliance on Mental Illness of Greater Orlando (NAMIGO) – \$2,500. This contribution will provide funding in support of the 2022 Annual NAMIWalks annual fundraiser on Saturday, April 23, 2022. NAMIGO is a partner of local law enforcement agencies and Aspire Health Partners in educating first responders in the appropriate skills of dealing with those who suffer a mental illness.

Orlando Community and Youth Trust - \$25,000. This contribution will provide funding in support of the Dueling Dragons of Orlando program where the goal is to break down racial barriers, teach teamwork, mentor teens, change stereotypes, build relationships, and improve the lives of youth from communities of color.

Florida Missing Children's Day Foundation - \$500. This contribution will provide funding in support of the 2022 Florida Missing Children's Day ceremony to be held on Monday, September 12, 2022. The ceremony and child safety events are an integral component of Florida's ongoing efforts to raise awareness and educate the public about missing person issues.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$28,000 from the FY 2022 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for eligible contributions to the National Alliance on Mental Illness of Greater Orlando (\$2,500), Orlando Community and Youth Trust (\$25,000), and Florida Missing Children's Day Foundation (\$500).

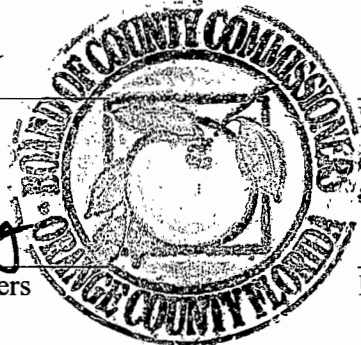

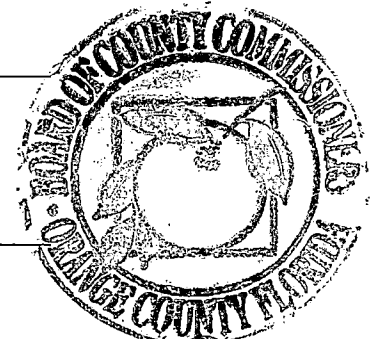
