ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval of Amendment No. 5, Contract Y16-1014, Sodium Hypochlorite, with Allied Universal Corporation, in the amount of \$562,760, for a revised contract amount of \$2,373,800.

PROCUREMENT:

This amendment will extend the contract for 90 days while a procurement process is completed and will provide additional funding to meet projected needs based on the County's usage to date to ensure availability of resources without interruption in the supply of sodium hypochlorite for the Water Reclamation Division and for use in the facility's disinfection processes.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account numbers 4420 038 1324 4151, 4420 038 1355 4151, and 4420 038 1351 4151.

APPROVALS:

The Water Operations Division concurs with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

On May 10, 2016, the Board approved award of contract Y16-1014 to Allied Universal Corporation in the amount of \$1,120,000 for the contract period of June 1, 2016 through May 31, 2017.
