Orange County Sheriff's Office Request

The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$20,000 from the FY 2022 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for the following purposes:

International Conference of Police Chaplains – \$10,000. This contribution will assist with underwriting the educational and professional development courses offered through the International Conference of Police Chaplains and provide professional development.

Orange County Police Athletic League - \$10,000. This contribution will assist in hosting community service projects while learning about the many aspects of the criminal justice system and the Police Athletic League programs.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$20,000 from the FY 2022 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for eligible contributions to the International Conference of Police Chaplains (\$10,000) and Orange County Police Athletic League (\$10,000).

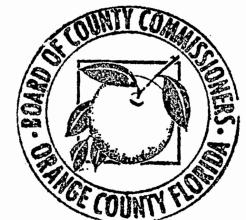
