SUBJECT:	Approval of Contracts, Request for Proposals Y23-132-JA, Civil Engineering, Planning, Vertical Construction Management and Real Estate Acquisition Staff Augmentation - Term Contract

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

Approval to Award Contracts, Request for Proposals Y23-132-JA, Civil Engineering, Planning, Vertical Construction Management and Real Estate Acquisition Staff Augmentation – Term Contract, Lot A to Moten Tate, Inc., in the amount of \$2,093,208 and Visium Resources, Inc., in the amount of \$3,534,440 for a five-year term, Lot B to Moten Tate, Inc., in the amount of \$601,744 and Visium Resources, Inc., in the amount of \$953,680 for a five-year term, Lot C to Moten Tate, Inc., in the amount of \$869,003.20 and Visium Resources, Inc., in the amount of \$1,618,656 for a five-year term, Lot D to Moten Tate, Inc., in the amount of \$1,043,952 and Visium Resources, Inc., in the amount of \$1,929,200 for a five-year term, and Lot E to Moten Tate, Inc., in the amount of \$2,514,304 and Visium Resources, Inc., in the amount of \$3,961,360 for a five-year term. Further request Board authorization for the Procurement Division to renew the contracts for two additional one-year terms.

The item was evaluated by the Procurement Committee on June 21, 2023. Commissioner Emily Bonilla was assigned to the Procurement Committee.

### PROCUREMENT:

The contracts will supplement County staff in performing the duties needed to design and construct roadway infrastructure and safety improvements. These consultants will be used for both short-term assignments and long-term projects.

### FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 1002-072-5144-3179. Delivery Orders will be issued on an as-needed basis.

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#### APPROVALS:

The Public Works Department and Business Development Division concur with this recommendation.

#### REMARKS:

Three proposals were received in response to this Request for Proposals (RFP). The Procurement Committee evaluated the proposals in accordance with the criteria set forth in the subject RFP. The proposal for Sunshine Enterprise USA, LLC scored too low for Board consideration.
