On September 19, 2024, the Board approved an estimated budget for the Air Pollution Control - Section 105 (EPA 105) Grant in the amount of \$200,000. The U.S. Department of Environmental Protection Agency awarded the grant in the amount of \$100,000, which represents a decrease in the amount of \$100,000.

On July 21, 2025, the U.S. Department of Environmental Protection Agency released year two of EPA 105 funding in the amount of \$123,283 for a new total award amount of \$223,283. Also, the budget period for this grant was extended through September 30, 2026. These funds will be used to support Section 105 environmental program grant which includes permitting, ambient air monitoring, compliance, and enforcement activities.
