SUBJECT: Approval of Amendment No. 4, Contract Y20-2013, Provision of Community  
Services and Facility Use

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval of Amendment No. 4, Contract Y20-2013, Provision of Community Services and Facility Use, with Coalition for the Homeless of Central Florida, Inc., in the amount of \$70,936, for a revised contract total amount of \$212,808.

PROCUREMENT:

This amendment will extend the contract for the period of July 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023 and adds additional funding to cover the extension. Aligning the contract dates to the calendar year allows this contract to provide continuity of services accompanied by calendar year funding.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 0001-062-2556-8610.

APPROVALS:

The Citizens' Commission for Children Division concurs with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

The Board approved Contract Y20-2013 on February 25, 2020. Coalition for the Homeless of Central Florida, Inc. is currently providing satisfactory services under this contract, such as Innovation Programming for Homeless Youth and their Families which provides a new child development program available to homeless children and youth, focusing on resolving and improving behavioral mental health, developmental relational, family integration, education, and socialization issues.

Previous amendments to the contract are as follows:

Amendment No. 1: Updated Attachment A with Attachment A Rv1.

Amendment No. 2: Renewed the contract for the period of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022. Updated Attachment A, Article XI, Article XIII, Article XIV, Article XV and Exhibits B and C. The contract amount remained unchanged.

Amendment No. 3: Renewed the contract for the period of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023. The contract amount remained unchanged.
