

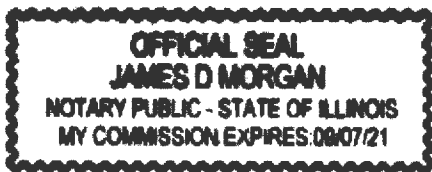

ORANGE COUNTY NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

Notice is hereby given that on **Tuesday, September 1, 2020**, beginning at 2:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matters may be heard, the **Orange County Board of County Commissioners (BCC)** will hold public hearings in the cases described below. The BCC will hold these hearings either "in person" at the First Floor of the Orange County Administration Center, 201 S. Rosalind Avenue in downtown Orlando, Florida, OR "virtually," utilizing communications media technology, with the latter made permissible pursuant to Governor Ron DeSantis's Emergency Executive Order No. 20-69 related to the Covid-19 state of emergency, as amended, OR a combination of both formats. At the time of publication of this notice, it could not be known by Orange County whether these hearings would be held in person, virtually, or a combination of both formats. In order to determine the format of these public hearings or if you have any questions, please call the **Orange County Environmental Protection Division** at 407-836-1400 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except legal holidays, or visit the County Calendar at <https://www.ocfl.net/Home/CountyCalendar.aspx>.

The hearings will be hosted by Mayor Jerry L. Demings, a quorum of the BCC will be maintained during the hearings, and the hearings will be conducted and operated by Orange County Government.

If the hearings are held virtually, the BCC members will be participating from different locations via WebEx . (See <https://www.webex.com> for more information.)

Description of the Hearings:

1. Applicant: Coburn Mikacich

Request for a Shoreline Alteration/ Dredge and Fill Permit SADF # 20-07-015 to construct a natural stone seawall along a portion of the shoreline of Lake Holden; pursuant to Orange County Code, Chapter 15, Article VI, Pumping and Dredging Control.

Location: District 3; on property adjacent to Lake Holden, located at 907 Springwood Drive, Orlando, Florida. (The legal property description is on file at the Environmental Protection Division.)

2. Applicant: David Harding

Request for a Shoreline Alteration/ Dredge and Fill Permit SADF # 20-05-010 to construct a new seawall along a portion of the shoreline of Lake Conway, pursuant to Orange County Code, Chapter 33, Article 11, Lake Conway Water and Navigation Control District.

Location: District 3; on property adjacent to Lake Conway, located at 4843 Backacre Lane, Orange County, Florida. (The legal property description is on file at the Environmental Protection Division.)

If the hearings are held in person, the hearings may also be observed by appearing at the First Floor of the Orange County Administration Center at 201 S. Rosalind Avenue in downtown Orlando, Florida, where Orange County staff will be present to ensure that social distancing and other health and safety measures are practiced and enforced.

Participating in a Hearing:

If you wish to provide testimony and evidence during a hearing, you must utilize one of the following options:

- If the hearing is being held in person, you may attend the hearing at the First Floor of the Orange County Administration Center, 201 S. Rosalind Avenue, Orlando, Florida.

- If the hearing is being held virtually, in whole or in part, you may participate in one of the following two ways:

You may appear at Room 105 on the First Floor of the Orange County Administration Center, 201 S. Rosalind Avenue, Orlando, Florida, where you will be able to communicate virtually via WebEx with the BCC members at a kiosk equipped with a computer laptop and video camera, or

You may participate in the hearing and communicate with the BCC members virtually via WebEx from a remote location through the video section of WebEx found in the link in the County Calendar at <https://www.ocfl.net/Home/CountyCalendar.aspx>. If you desire to participate from a remote location, please register via the link provided in the County Calendar by not later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, August 31, 2020, so that Orange County may register your name and make arrangements to ensure that you are able to participate in the hearing via WebEx from the remote location.

Regardless of the form of participation, the time allotted to you and each other person who provides testimony will be at the sole discretion of the Mayor, and may be reduced from the usual time limit of three minutes to two minutes, depending on the number of participants.

If you appear at the First Floor of the Orange County Administration Center, 201 S. Rosalind Avenue, Orlando, Florida, Orange County staff will be present to assist at the kiosk in Room 105 and on the First Floor to ensure that social distancing and other health and safety measures are practiced and enforced.

presentations, reports, or any other documents when you testify at the hearing, it is requested that by not later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, August 31, 2020, you either email true and correct copies of such documentary evidence to Public.Comment@ocfl.net and note the public hearing or public hearing number to which it relates, or physically deliver copies of such documentary evidence to the Planning Division at the Second Floor of the Orange County Administration Center at 201 S. Rosalind Avenue in downtown Orlando, Florida.

Section 286.0105, Florida Statutes, states that "if a person decides to appeal any decision made by a board, agency or commission with respect to any matter considered at a meeting or hearing, he or she will need a record of the proceedings, and that, for such purpose, he or she may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based."
