Ordinance No. 2021-75 Annexing the Subject Property at 3551 S. Orange Ave. of Approximately 0.34 Acres (Massey Annexation)(Economic Development)

Summary:

Ordinance No. 2021-75 will annex 0.34 acres located at 3551 S. Orange Avenue, known as the Massey Property, generally located east of S. Orange Avenue and south of Highway Place.

The property currently contains an office building and parking lot. The subject property is contiguous to the City limits and are reasonably compact.

The petition for annexation is on the concurrent agenda, in the form of an Annexation and Developer's Agreement. Pursuant to Section 65.260, Orlando City Code, the Chief Administrative Officer waived the requirement that the Technical Review Committee and Municipal Planning Board (MPB) review the application for annexation before consideration by the Orlando City Council. The first reading of this ordinance was held November 8, 2021.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA, ANNEXING TO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY CERTAIN LAND GENERALLY LOCATED EAST OF SOUTH ORANGE AVENUE, WEST OF S. ROSALIND AVENUE AND NORTH OF JENNIE JEWEL DRIVE, AND COMPRISED OF 0.34 ACRES OF LAND, MORE OR LESS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, CORRECTION OF SCRIVENER'S ERRORS, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the owners of property comprised of approximately 0.34 acres and generally located east of South Orange Avenue, west of S. Rosalind Avenue, and north of Jennie Jewel Drive (hereinafter "the Property"), petitioned the Orlando City Council for voluntary annexation pursuant to Chapter 171.044, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Property is precisely described by the legal description of the area by metes and bounds attached to this ordinance as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 65.260, Orlando City Code, the Chief Administrative Officer or his designee waived the requirement that the Technical Review Committee and Municipal Planning Board review the application for annexation before consideration by the Orlando City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Orlando City Council hereby finds that:

- 1. As of the date of the petition, the property was located in the unincorporated area of Orange County; and
- 2. As of the date of the petition, the property is contiguous to the city within the meaning of subsection 171.031(11), Florida Statutes; and
- 3. As of the date of the petition, the property is reasonably compact within the meaning of subsection 171.031(12), Florida Statutes; and
- 4. The petition bears the signatures of all owners of property in the area to be annexed; and
- 5. Annexation of the property will not result in the creation of enclaves within the meaning of subsection 171.031(13), Florida Statutes; and
 - 6. The property is located wholly within the boundaries of a single county; and
- 7. The petition proposes an annexation that is consistent with the purpose of ensuring sound urban development and accommodation to growth; and
- 8. The petition, this ordinance, and the procedures leading to the adoption of this ordinance are consistent with the uniform legislative standards provided by the Florida Municipal Annexation and Contraction Act for the adjustment of municipal boundaries; and

- 9. The petition proposes an annexation that is consistent with the purpose of ensuring the efficient provision of urban services to areas that become urban in character within the meaning of subsection 171.031(8), Florida Statutes; and
- 10. The petition proposes an annexation that is consistent with the purpose of ensuring that areas are not annexed unless municipal services can be provided to those areas; and
- WHEREAS, the Orlando City Council hereby finds that this ordinance is in the best interest of the public health, safety, and welfare, and is consistent with the applicable provisions of Florida Statutes and the city's GMP and LDC; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

- **SECTION 1. ANNEXATION.** Pursuant to the authority granted by section 171.044, Florida Statutes, and having determined that the owner or owners of the property have petitioned the Orlando City Council for annexation into the corporate limits of the city, and having determined that the petition bears the signatures of all owners of property in the area proposed to be annexed, and having made the findings set forth in this ordinance, the property is hereby annexed into the corporate limits of the City of Orlando, Florida, and the boundary lines of the city are hereby redefined to include the property. In accordance with subsection 171.044(3), Florida Statutes, the annexed area is clearly shown on the map attached to this ordinance as **Exhibit B**.
- **SECTION 2. CITY BOUNDARIES.** Pursuant to section 171.091, Florida Statutes, the charter boundary article of the city is hereby revised in accordance with this ordinance. The city clerk, or designee, is hereby directed to file this ordinance as a revision of the City Charter with the Florida Department of State. The city planning official, or designee, is hereby directed to amend the city's official maps in accordance with this ordinance.
- **SECTION 3. SCRIVENER'S ERROR.** The city attorney may correct scrivener's errors found in this ordinance by filing a corrected copy of this ordinance with the city clerk.
- **SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY.** If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are severable.
- **SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance is effective upon adoption, except for sections one and two, which take effect on the 30th day after adoption.




