RECOMMENDATION:

Selection of one firm and an alternate to provide Engineering Services for Kirby Smith Forcemain, Reclaimed Water Main, and Storage Tank Project, Request for Proposals Y19-822-TA, from the following firms listed alphabetically. Further request authorization for the Procurement Division to negotiate and execute a contract provided within a budget not to exceed \$2,400,000.

CPH, Inc.

Reiss Engineering, Inc.

The Procurement Committee evaluated the proposals on August 21, 2019. Commissioner Betsy VanderLey was assigned to the Procurement Committee.

PURPOSE:

This project consists of the design, permitting, and construction administration for the construction of approximately 23,000 linear feet of transmission forcemain to convey wastewater generated in the existing and future development areas within the East Service Area to the Eastern Water Reclamation Facility. The project will also include approximately 25,200 linear feet of reclaimed water main to enhance the reclaimed water main projected capacity to the Wewahootee Storage and Repump Facility. An additional 1.5 million gallon (MG) storage tank and a 3,000 gallons per minute pumping capacity and miscellaneous appurtenances will be added at the Wewahootee Storage and Repump Facility. This will provide more storage for peak reclaimed water demands in the area and will bring the total reuse storage capacity to 3.0 MG. The work is located in District 4.

DISCUSSION:

Two proposals were received in response to the Request for Proposals (RFP). The Procurement Committee evaluated the proposals in accordance with the criteria set forth in the RFP. Consensus scores from the Procurement Committee are attached.

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Request for Proposals, Y19-822-TA, Engineering Services for Kirby Smith Forcemain, Reclaimed Water Main, and Storage Tank Project

A timely protest was filed by Reiss Engineering, Inc. The protest committee heard the protest on September 23, 2019, resulting in a unanimous vote to modify the location score for Reiss Engineering, Inc., due to a calculation error. Additionally, they unanimously voted to uphold the procurement committee scoring, as revised and advance the award recommendation to the top ranked firm.
