- SUBJECT: Ratification of Sub-Recipient Agreement Y20-2370, Expansion of Telehealth Services, COVID-19 Testing, and Protective Measures for Uninsured Residents

ACTION REQUESTED:

Ratification of Sub-Recipient Agreement Y20-2370, Expansion of Telehealth Services, COVID-19 Testing, and Protective Measures for Uninsured Residents, with Grace Medical Home, Inc., in the not-to-exceed amount of \$183,625.75.

PROCUREMENT:

Orange County received \$243.1M in federal CARES Act funding and allocated \$48.6 million of the funding for public safety and health expenditures. This sub-recipient agreement will provide medical care to uninsured residents. Funding will cover two medical screeners, flu and COVID-19 tests, test machines, telehealth technology expenses, technology expenses, and an awning to be used as a screening area. Funding will also provide personal protective equipment and staff testing for COVID-19, which will allow Grace Medical Home, Inc. to continue to provide medical care to uninsured residents. The period of performance is March 1, 2020 to December 30, 2020.

Funding is available in the account number 5895-019-8019-8610.

APPROVALS:

The Health Services Department concurs with this recommendation.

<u>REMARKS:</u>

In accordance with the Code of Ordinances, Part I, Chapter 17, Article III, Section 17-286 – Application and exclusions, agreements between the Board and nonprofit organizations are excluded from competitive procurement requirements. The services provided will be in dental, mental health, primary care and specialty care services for uninsured residents to reduce the utilization of the area's emergency departments.
