Approval of Amendment No. 3, Contract Y15-802, Engineering Services Town Center (PS #3497) and South Central (PS #3499) Master Pump Stations Improvements, with Tetra Tech, Inc., in the amount of \$115,216.61, for a revised total contract amount of \$710,800.88.

PROCUREMENT:

This amendment will provide additional construction administration phase services required by the County. The additional engineering effort includes review and respond to requests for information, shop drawings resubmittals, and additional construction progress meetings required. This project is located in Districts 1 and 4.

DISCUSSION:
