Package Four

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y21-700-TA, Utilities Group Forcemain Package Four, to the low responsive and responsible bidder, Metro Equipment Service, Inc. in the estimated contract award amount of \$2,424,417.33.

PROCUREMENT:

Work under this contract includes the installation of approximately 6,372 linear feet of 4-inch, 6-inch, 8-inch, and 12-inch Dimension Ratio (DR) 18 PVC forcemain, approximately 275 linear feet of 12-inch DR 14 PVC forcemain by open cut, and 225 linear feet of 12-inch High Density Polyethylene forcemain by horizontal directional drill. The project also includes the removal of approximately 1,948 linear feet of 8-inch asbestos cement (AC) pipe and the grouting of approximately 2,124 linear feet of 6-inch and 8-inch AC and/or PVC forcemain pipe. This project is located in District 1.

Funding is available in account number 4420-038-1539-0013-6340.

APPROVALS:

The Utilities Engineering and Business Development Divisions concur with this recommendation

REMARKS:

Nine bids were received in response to this Invitation for Bids and were evaluated for responsiveness, responsibility, and price reasonableness. The bids submitted by Young's Communications, LLC, Pospiech Contracting, Inc., R.P. Utility & Excavation Corp., Benchmark Construction Co., Inc. Schuller Contractors Incorporated, and Intercounty Engineering, Inc. were deemed non-responsive for failing to achieve the M/WBE requirements. Valencia Construction Group, Inc. was deemed non-responsible for failing to meet reference requirements.

Page 2 Award of Invitation for Bids Y21-700-TA, Utilities Group Forcemain Package Four

A timely protest was filed by Schuller Contractors Incorporated. A protest review was held by the Procurement Manager on April 6, 2021. The protest was denied and was not appealed.

The bid submitted by Metro Equipment Service, Inc. is considered reasonable based on the engineer's estimate. The submitted bid documents were determined to be responsive and the references provided were satisfactory for this type of work, thus Metro Equipment Service, Inc. has been determined to be responsible as well. Therefore, award is recommended to Metro Equipment Service, Inc.

The Business Development Division evaluated all eight bids submitted for this project. The Business Development Division completed an M/WBE Availability Analysis. The scope of services for this project had Minority/Women Business Enterprise availability. As a result, the M/WBE goal will remain at 25%. At the time of bid opening, at least 120 M/WBE firms were certified to provide the scope of services at the subcontract level.

The apparent low bidder, Young's Communications, LLC, did not achieve good faith effort documentation. While the low bidder reported \$432,370.00 in M/WBE participation, the listed firm is not currently Orange County certified M/WBE.

The second low bid, submitted by Pospiech Contracting, Inc., did not achieve good faith effort documentation. While the second low bidder reported \$77,500.00 in M/WBE participation, one of the listed firms is not currently Orange County certify. For the firm certified, they did not specify the work to be performed on attachment C-2. Therefore, the M/WBE participation could not be confirmed.

The third low bid, submitted by R. P. Utility & Excavation Corp., did not achieve good faith effort documentation. While the third low bidder reported \$472,766.00 in M/WBE participation, one listed firm is not an Orange County certified M/WBE firm. For the firms certified, they did not specify the work to be performed on attachment C-2. Therefore, the M/WBE participation could not be confirmed.

While the fourth low bidder reported \$281,789.08 in M/WBE participation, one listed firm is not Orange County certified. For the firms certified, they did not specify the work to be performed on attachment C-2. Therefore, the M/WBE participation could not be confirmed.

While the fifth low bidder reported \$316,491.50 in M/WBE participation, one listed firm is not an Orange County certified M/WBE firm. For the firms certified, they did not specify the scope of classification on attachment C-2. Therefore, the M/WBE participation could not be confirmed.
