SUBJECT: October 22, 2019 – Work Session  
Dual Rear Wheel Vehicles in Residential Areas

During the Open Discussion period of the May 7, 2019 Board meeting, District 6 Commissioner Victoria P. Siplin described a recent spike in complaints regarding dual rear wheel vehicles parking in several residential neighborhoods in the Pine Hills area. Brief discussion by the Board highlighted that this problem is occurring in other areas of the County and that enforcement efforts have been unable to properly manage the issue. The Board discussed pedestrian safety concerns these large vehicles cause when parked on neighborhood streets, along with monetary penalties (civil fines, parking tickets) that may not be high enough to provide a disincentive, and the potential lack of parking options for commercial vehicles involved in freight transport and delivery in the County.

This work session will cover the current code standards, incidents data, enforcement procedures and standards in other jurisdictions, along with a summary and options for consideration.
